FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

SUNDESTIN OWNERS' ASSOCIATION

- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A: ONE VOTE PER UNIT OWNED (VOTING CERTIFICATE DESIGNATING A VOTER FOR UNITS OWNED BY PARTNERSHIPS AND CORPORATIONS IS REQUIRED)

- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- A: SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DWELLING ONLY; UNIT MAY NOT BE SUBDIVIDED OR DIVIDED INTO A SMALLER UNIT
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on the leasing of my unit?
- A: UNITS MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED SUBJECT TO A LEASE: UNITS MAY NOT BE LEASED AND SOLD SUBJECT TO A LEASE
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
- A: MAINTENANCE FEES ARE \$455.00 PER MONTH FOR ONE BEDROOM UNITS; \$466.00 FOR TWO BEDROOM UNITS AND \$835.00 FOR THREE BEDROOM UNITS. THE FEE INCLUDES ELECTRICAL POWER UTILITY, CABLE SERVICE (BASIC AND HBO), PHONE, WATER/SEWER AND RUBBISH PICK UP FOR EACH UNIT AND FUNDS THE OPERATING BUDGET.
- Q: Do I have to be a member of any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in the association? Also, how much are my assessments?
- A: NO
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A: NO
- Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If so identify each such case.
