AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF CONDOMINIUM OF PELICAN BEACH RESORT, A CONDOMINIUM

Article XI is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE XI. PURCHASERS' CONDOMINIUM FUND

At the time the Developer sells and closes a condominium unit to a purchaser, purchaser thereby becoming a unit owner in this condominium, such purchaser shall deposit the equivalent of two-(2) months assessments which amounts shall be deposited to the purchasors' condominium fund to pay advance utility deposits, insurance trustee fees, advance premiums on casualty, worker's compensation and liability policies and for the purpose of defraying operating expenses as may arise during the initial period of condominium ownership. This deposit is not a regular contribution of, nor is it in lieu of, the monthly maintenance fee, the balance of such funds shall be used by the condominium Association for future operating expenses.

ARTICLE XI. PURCHASERS' CONDOMINIUM FUND

The purchaser of any ownership interest in a Unit subsequent to the effective date of this amendment shall pay to the Association at the time of acquisition of such ownership interest, a sum equal to \$100 (or any amount approved by the State of Florida) transfer fee to the Association. The Board may use the funds so collected for any purpose for which the Board of Directors is authorized to use Association funds.
